

How to Disable the Autoset

This application note describes how to manually disable (or enable) the GDS-1000-U's Autoset function.

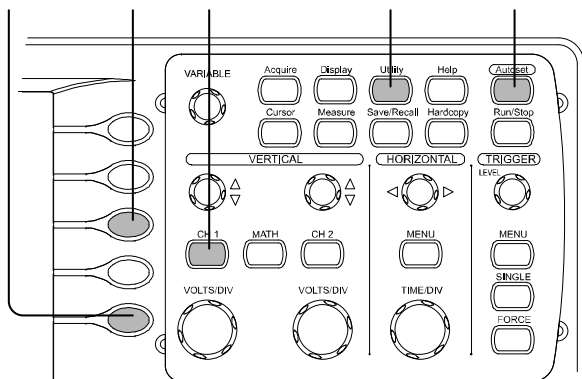
Procedure

1. Turning on the GDS-1000 Power the GDS-1000 up.
2. Accessing the factory menu Press the front panel keys in the following order.

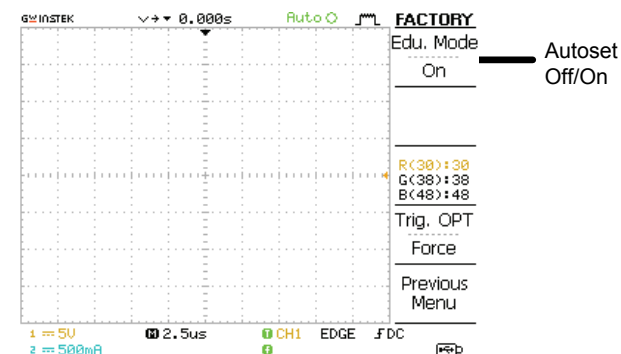
Order	Item	Number of time to press
1st	CH1 key	once
2nd	F5 key	six times
3rd	Utility key	once
4th	F5 key	twice
5th (end)	F3 key	once

Front panel

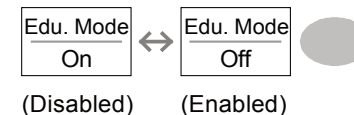
F5 key F3 key CH1 key Utility key Autoset key



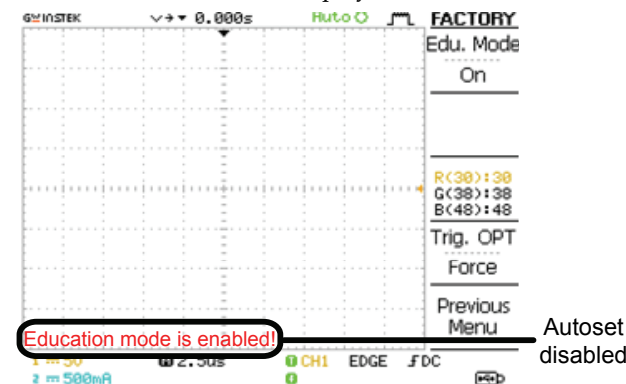
3. Factory menu contents The factory setting screen, shown below, should appear in the display.



4. Disabling (enabling) the Autoset Press the F1 key to disable (Off) or enable (On) the Autoset.



5. Confirming the setting After changing the Edu. Mode enable/disable setting, connect a signal to the GDS-1000-U CH1 input and press the Autoset key. If the Autoset is being disabled, the following warning message should also appear in the bottom left corner of the display.
